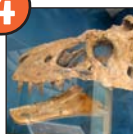


## Juvenile *Daspletosaurus*

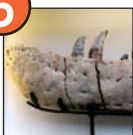


## "The Bisti Beast"

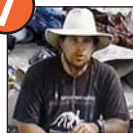


## Rex Extinction

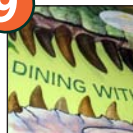


## *T. rex* Track
