to 146 m.y.a.)

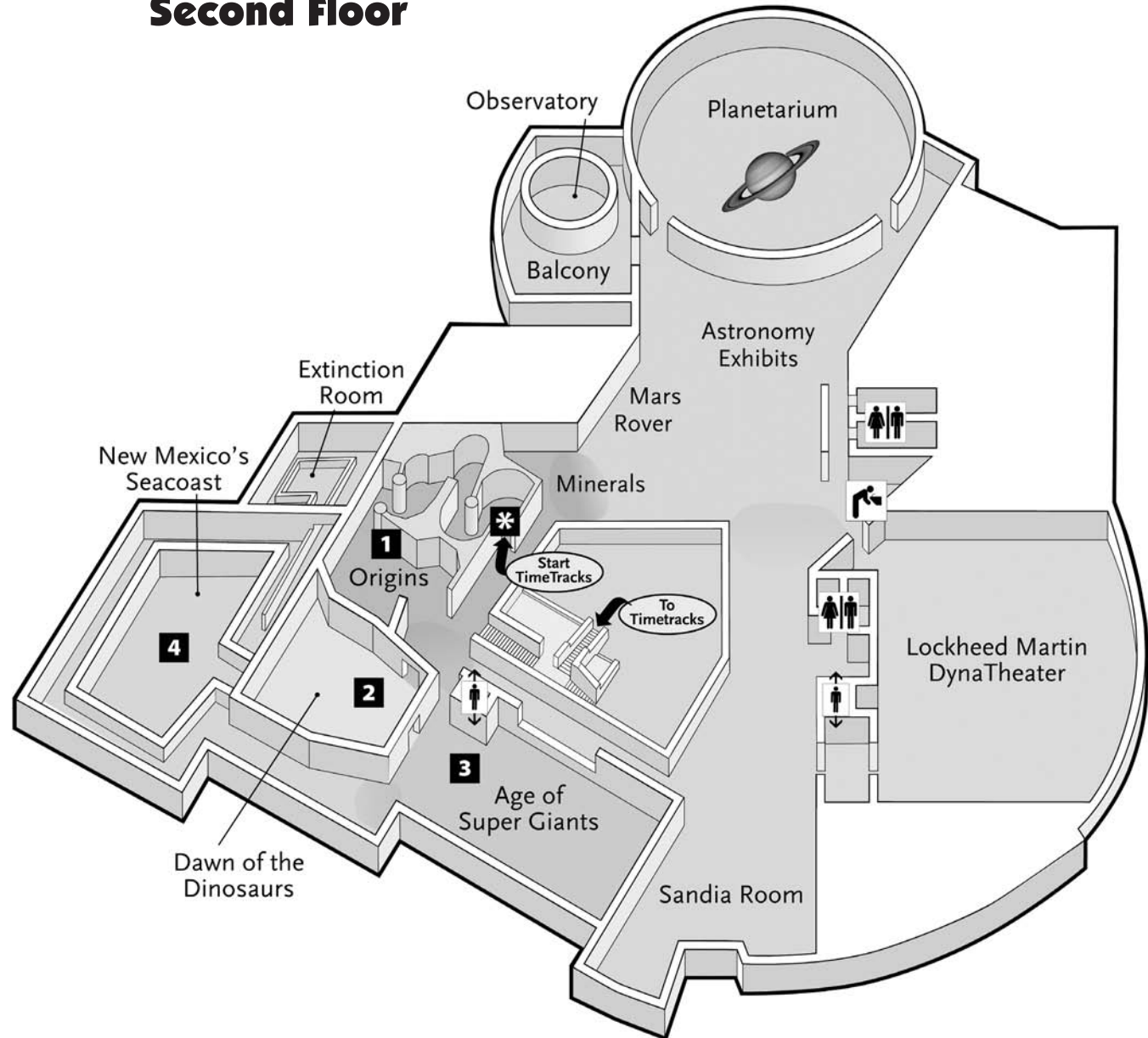


**4 New Mexico's Seacoast**

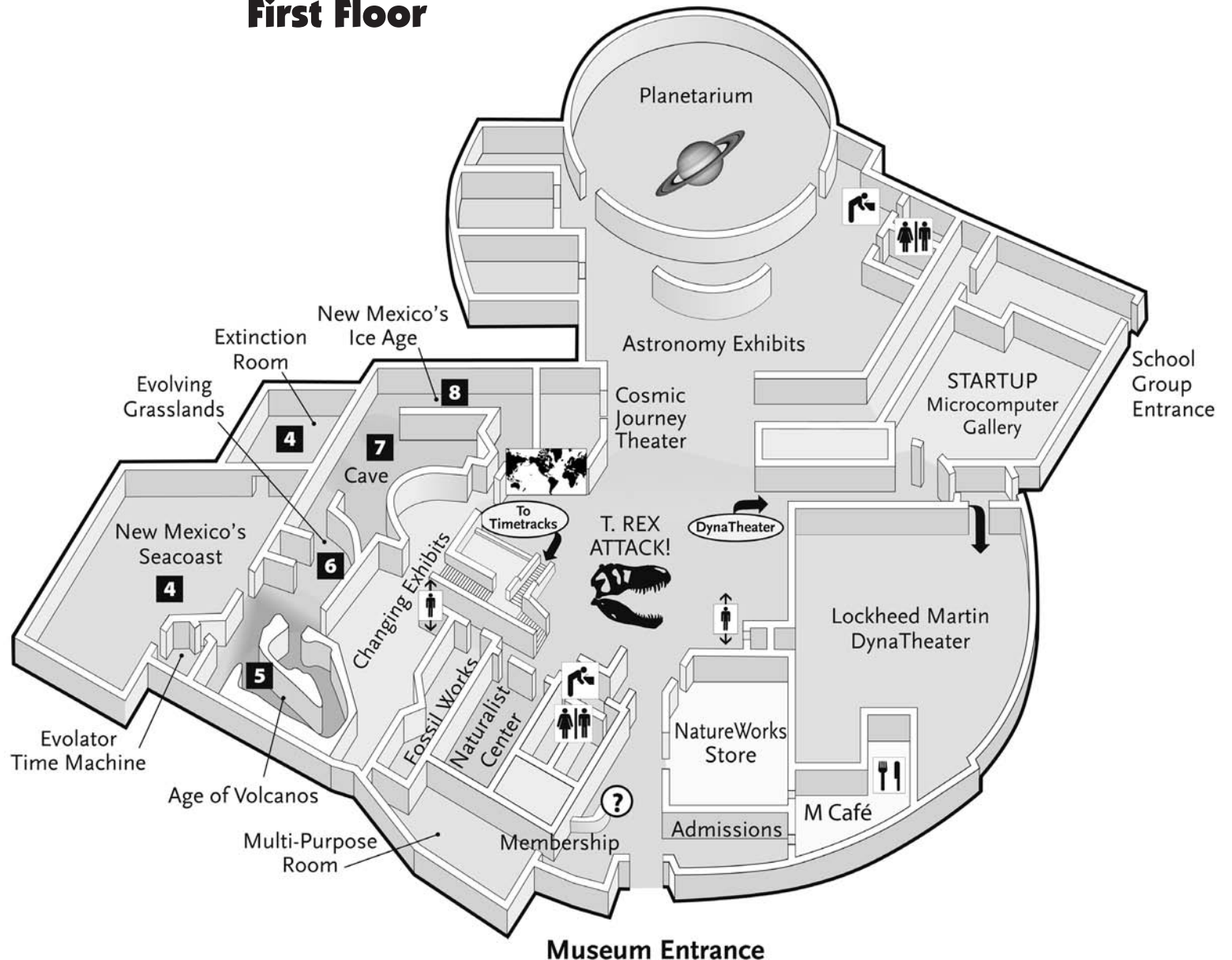
**4** **New Mexico's Seacoast**
